



KANAHA BEACH PARK Campground Rules

Permits:

1. Kanaha Beach Park Campground is closed on Monday and Tuesday for maintenance.
2. Permits are required for all camping at designated camp sites and must be displayed at all times.
3. Keep payment receipt for verification by Park Ranger or Security Staff.
4. Site numbers 1 – 12 are available daily, except Mondays and Tuesdays when campground is closed.
5. Permits can be acquired through any of the County's park district offices.
6. Permits shall be limited to a maximum of **3** consecutive nights for each camper.
7. Applicants for camping permits must be eighteen years of age or older.
8. Permit holders are responsible for the conduct of all campers in their group.
9. Each permit is limited to 6 campers, 2 vehicles, and one licensed dog.
10. All campers must be registered on the permit.
11. Vehicles are allowed in the designated campground parking lot only.
12. Only camping and recreation equipment is allowed at the campsite. Please keep gear to a minimum to prevent encroaching on other campsites.
13. Campsites must be **vacated by 12:00 noon** on check out day. Please keep your campsite clean and free of litter. Dispose of all trash in campground containers.
14. Only campers issued permits are allowed to enter or remain in the campgrounds between the hours of **8:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m.**
15. **Quiet hours** are from **10:00 p.m. until 7:00 a.m.** and are enforced. Please consider your neighbors and keep campsite noise low.

Pets:

1. Your dog must wear its license and be kept leashed at all times.
2. Pets must not be left unattended or allowed to encroach on other camper's sites.
3. Excessive barking will not be tolerated.
4. When walking your dog, please carry plastic bags and dispose of pet waste in trash cans. Pets left unattended will be reported to the County Animal Control Office.

Fires:

1. No fires are allowed in the park or campground, except when used for cooking purposes in park supplied barbecues.
2. Use of personal barbeque or hibachi is allowed when placed in a safe location and does not impact other campers.
3. No cutting of trees or foliage of any kind is permitted.
