

RECYCLE ALL YOUR CLEAN, RINSED METAL FOOD CANS

Take them to your nearest Residential Recycling Drop-Off Center

What to Recycle:

- ☞ All metal food and beverage cans, including aluminum, steel, tin and bi-metal cans



How to Prepare:

- ☞ Empty, Clean & Rinse all metal food cans
- ☞ Remove & Discard tops (workers sort the cans by hand; loose or partially attached tops are not safe for handling)
- ☞ Labels may be left on and cans may be flattened
- ☞ Remove cans from the bag or container you brought them in and place them in the small recycling bin for ALUMINUM & METAL CANS

PLEASE KOKUA: IF YOU CAN'T RINSE IT - DON'T RECYCLE IT!!

Excess food residue will contaminate the whole load and cause it to be rejected by the metals buyer/recycler.

What is NOT recyclable in the METAL CANS Recycling Drop Box:

- ☞ Aerosol, paint or solvent cans
- ☞ Aluminum foil or trays
- ☞ Scrap metals, furniture or window frames
